ROCKSTARS Dominate at the Dirtworks 100



A beautiful autumn day greeted more than 1000 riders who set off for the 50km and 100km Dirtworks MTB Marathons.

As the gun went off it was again **ROCKSTAR** Troy Glennan who made the 1st attack. At 10km on the first long steep climb, Troy broke away. A chasing bunch, Peter Hatton, Matt Fleming and **ROCKSTAR** Craig Gordon caught Troy at the 35km mark. The 4 contenders continued to power on together until a broken stick destroyed Troy's drive train - ending his race prematurely.

The remaining 3 leaders hit the 70km point and Hatton attacked. Craig Gordon was the only rider able to go with him. For the remaining 30km the two riders continued to battle each other. As they crossed the line for a sprint finish it was Peter Hatton 1st with **ROCKSTAR** Craig Gordon 1 second down in 2nd. Matt Fleming crossed the line 2 minutes down in 3rd place.

ROCKSTAR RACING'S Shaun Lewis and Hamish Elliot came in 4th and 5th respectively, giving the team 3 places in the top 5.

The Team will now set its sights on the Capital Punishment Marathon in Canberra on the 29th May.
